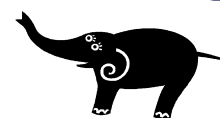

A retired high school educator and mentor teacher of 34 years, Ruth has found her retirement calling working to restore and defend the integrity of the electoral process in California.

The Election Integrity Project, Inc. was founded in December, 2010, and Ruth became San Diego Coordinator in February of 2011. She served on the Board of EIP from 2012 to 2017, and in that year she and Linda Paine co-founded **Election Integrity Project® California, Inc.** (EIPCa).

Ruth currently serves on the Board of EIPCa as Vice President, Director of Legislative Oversight and Director of Education and Training, while continuing to coordinate San Diego County.
